RE: KHU ODEL REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS

Greetings

Following the closure of the Universities by the Government in March 2020 due to Covid-19 pandemic the University Governing Council, Senate and Management after extensive consultations resolved that the University develops an ODeL Learning Management System (LMS). This decision was made in order to allow our University to continue with teaching and learning. The KHU ODeL LMS is now functional and will be used to facilitate teaching and learning starting from the first week of September 2020 semester.

As a result of the development of the ODeL LMS students are required to meet the following:

1. Register for the September semester using University Academic Management System (AMIS) (see portals link on the website). Registration should include full names, admission number, and current phone number
2. Digital device for accessing ODeL LMS (e.g. laptop, desktop computer, tablet etc.)
3. A valid phone number which will be whitelisted by internet service providers (e.g. Safaricom, Airtel or Telkom) for student discounted bundles (KES 500 = 10GB per month) for eLearning.
4. Attend KHU ODeL LMS student training virtually (the date will be posted on the website).
5. Be cleared by Finance Office. You are required to pay at least 50% of the fees at the time of registration.

The University through the ODeL Office will offer all the necessary support for our students as we transition to ODeL as the new normal.
